In the beginning, God endowed man with certain inalienable rights. When men went under the authority of other men like Cain, Nimrod, the Pharaohs of Egypt, and even Saul and Caesar, the Bible records that we went *out of God's presence*, and even were *rejecting Him*, going into

bondage.

Abraham led many souls out of Ur and Haran, Moses led a nation out of bondage and set up a government where there was *no king*. If in Egypt, all the gold and silver was in the treasury of a government where the people had to pay one-fifth of everything they earned to that government and they called it bondage, then how can people today call a similar situation freedom?

“What is freedom? Freedom is the right to choose; the right to create for yourself the alternative of choice. Without the responsibility and exercise of choice, a man is not a man but a member, an instrument, a thing.” Archibald Macleish (1882-1982)

Why would God send Moses to bring the people out of that bondage, ordering the people to never to return to that state again, only to later send His Son to set up a church to deliver the

people back into a similar bondage? Doesn't the Bible say the *slothful shall be under tribute* and if you *sit at a table with ruler*, be careful what you accept, *And put a knife to thy throat, if thou [be] a man given to appetite. Be not desirous of his dainties: for they [are] deceitful meat”?*

Why did King David say, “Let their table become a snare before them: and that which should have been for their welfare, let it become a trap”? Paul repeats David's warning in Romans 11:9, “...Let their table be made a snare, and a trap...” The Bible is talking about the benefits offered by the benefactors of governments that exercise authority one over the other, which was prohibited by Christ. He told us to pray (apply) to our Father in Heaven, and to “call no man father upon the earth.” The governments of men who know not God only offer gifts, gratuities, and benefits provided at the expense of their neighbors. Peter warned us that through such covetous desires the people would become merchandise.

Edward Gibbon, in his book *The Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire*, praised “the union and discipline of the Christian republic,” explaining that the Church “gradually formed an independent and increasing state in the heart of the Roman Empire.” What did that early Church know that we do not?

Rome, Egypt, and Babylon brought the people into bondage through *social contracts*, but God said *to make no covenants with them nor with their gods*. The God of heaven desires that every man should be a free soul

under Him. What the early church taught was the perfect law of liberty which Christ called the Kingdom of God and His righteousness. The early Church through the teachings of Christ *turned the world upside down and set men free* but through sophistry of a watered down gospel and *traditions* the modern Church has again returned to bondage?

If we are to be free souls under God again we must learn the truth of how they followers of Christ were able to sustain themselves in the heart of the Roman Empire as its government decayed and collapsed. What was that early Church doing and how can we implement that divine plan in our lives today?
